

ATTENTION: To operate **special flights**, the Applicant at least 3 working days before the operation of flight(s) shall submit or send to the CAC of the RA an Application (see below) and the copies of the following documents:

1. Copies of pilot(s') licenses and medical certificates as defined in Appendix 1 to the Chicago Convention, and in the case of operating unmanned aircraft, the information about operator;
2. Air Operator's Certificate or Aircraft Registration Certificate;
3. An agreement for the lease or use of an aircraft, if the applicant is not the owner of the aircraft;
4. Aircraft type or model certificate or other equivalent document issued by a person with competent authority;
5. Aircraft Airworthiness Certificate or other equivalent document issued by a competent state authority or by the manufacturer of the aircraft;
6. Information on aircraft maintenance and continuing airworthiness management;
7. Flight technical and operational documentation for an aircraft, developed by the aircraft manufacturer, in the absence of complete information about the aircraft;
8. Program for flights;
9. Insurance / reinsurance certificates for crew, passengers, baggage, cargo and third party legal liability limits;
10. Aviation security program.

2. ICAO three-letter designator code of the air operator (if available)

3. State of registry of the aircraft

4. Aircraft type, nationality and registration marks, and the quantity

5. Purpose of flight

6. Date and time of flight operation

7. Airspace foreseen for flight operation, and aerodrome(s) in case of takeoff and landing

8. Minimum and maximum flight altitudes

9. Aircraft crew data and standard equipment of the aircraft
